AWEPA International Parliamentary Seminar on Peace, Security and Sustainable Development



On 8-9 October 2015, AWEPA held an international Parliamentary Seminar on "Peace, Security and Sustainable Development", with a special focus on the role of African and European Parliaments in tackling the Root Causes and Consequences of Violent Extremism and Terrorism. The seminar was organised in the framework of the AWEPA Millennium Development Goals

(MDGs) Programme, and was hosted by the Belgian Senate in Brussels and funded by the Swedish Development Agency (Sida). The theme for the high level seminar was chosen in light of growing international attention to the role of peace and security in the post-2015 development agenda.
